
## **Chandler Elementary**

## Important 5th Grade Culmination Information

- Culmination is Thursday June 8 at 8:30. Fifth grade students should arrive at their regular time of 8:00 am. The culmination event will take place on the blacktop at Chandler. This event should be short and take roughly 30 45 minutes. We will call each student up and say their name. There will not be seating for guests and there is no stage. Audience members will need to stand in order to see. Guests will be admitted beginning roughly at 8:15 through the main gate by the front door of the office.
- Culmination dress code for boys is, dress slacks, dress shirt, clean comfortable shoes. Ties, sport coats or suits are optional. Boys are not to wear tuxedos, tails, ruffled formal type shirts or hats. The dress code for girls is a dress/skirt and blouse and/or dress pants appropriate for this special occasion. Flat or low heeled shoes, also clean and comfortable. Girls are not to wear long or formal dresses, spaghetti strap tops, strapless or backless dresses or tops. Girls also are not to wear high-heeled shoes, hoops or evening gowns, long jewelry, gloves or hats.
- Additionally, we know that this is a time when many parents want to take their fifth graders to lunch, students will be allowed to leave at the conclusion of culmination with their parents only if they sign out through the child's teacher. If parents wish to take younger brothers and sisters who attend Chandler to culmination, they must come through the office.
